## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON TAX INCREASE

A tax rate of .0269 per \$100 valuation has been proposed by the governing body of GONZALES CO ES FIRE DIST .

The no-new-revenue tax rate is the tax rate for the 2020 tax year that will raise the same amount of property tax revenue for GONZALES CO ES FIRE DIST from the same properties in both the 2019 tax year and the 2020 tax year.

The voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate that GONZALES CO ES FIRE DIST may adopt without holding an election to seek voter approval of the rate, unless the de minimis rate for GONZALES CO ES FIRE DIST exceeds the voter-approval tax rate for GONZALES CO ES FIRE DIST.

The de minimis rate is the rate equal to the sum of the no-new-revenue maintenance and operations rate for GONZALES CO ES FIRE DIST, the rate that will raise \$500,000, and the current debt rate for GONZALES CO ES FIRE DIST.

The proposed tax rate is greater than the no-new-revenue tax rate. This means that GONZALES CO ES FIRE DIST is proposing to increase property taxes for the 2020 tax year.

A public hearing on the proposed tax rate will be held on August 27, 2020 at 4:00 PM at the Gonzales County Courthouse 414 Saint Joseph Street Gonzales Texas.

The proposed tax rate is not greater than the voter-approval tax rate. As a result, GONZALES CO ES FIRE DIST is not required to hold an election at which voters may accept or reject the proposed tax rate. However, you may express your support for or opposition to the proposed tax rate by contacting the members of the Board of Commissioners of GONZALES CO ES FIRE DIST at their offices or by attending the public meeting mentioned above.

The 86th Texas Legislature modified the manner in which the voter-approval tax rate is calculated to limit the rate of growth of property taxes in the state.
