  in the district. Motion passed unanimously. The Canvass was adopted by order 05-16-225.
- President Philippus and ESD Attorney Ken Campbell discussed the repeal of the
  Telecommunications Exemption. Brian Schauer made the motion seconded by Barry
  Boothe to Repeal the application of the exemption for the Telecommunications services
  sold within the district in conformance with the provisions of Section 323.208 and other
  applicable law. Motion passed unanimously by order 05-16-22-6.
- Brian Schauer made the motion seconded by Barry Boothe to appoint Crystal Cedillo, Tax Assessor-Collector as the individual to calculate and prepare the 2022 No-New Revenue and Voter-Approval Tax rates for the ESD#2. Motion passed unanimously.
